Soft Start to School Day:

From Monday 25th June, we are piloting a 'soft start' to the school day. School will open at 8:40am and the children can come straight into their classes as they arrive. They will be supervised by duty staff and will spend the ten minutes before class registration time reading or completing independent tasks. Please note that the school gate will be locked until 8.40am so do not drop children earlier than this (unless they are attending Out of School Club) as they will not be under our supervision. We hope that this will encourage a calmer start to the day and alleviate some of the parking issues that we have. We will review this pilot at the end of term in order to decide whether or not to continue this into the new term. Please let us have your thoughts and views.
