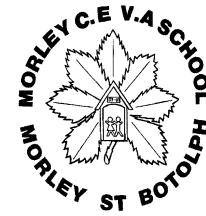

#### **Soft Start to School Day:**

We are at the end of the first week of the 'soft start' to school and after a tricky start on Monday (due to KS1 children needing to come in early on that day for their beach trip) it has worked well with the majority of children coming into class sensibly and calmly.
