The way the Qur'an is reflected in a Muslims life and its importance as a special book.  
How is the Torah used in Jewish worship?

### Key Vocabulary

<b>salvation</b>	Jesus' death and resurrection effect the rescue or salvation of humans. He open the way back to God. Through Jesus sin is dealt with, forgiveness offered, and the relationship between God and humans is restored.
<b>Qur'an</b>	The Quran is the central religious text of Islam, which Muslims believe to be a revelation from God. It is divided into chapters, which are then divided into verses. Muslims believe that the Quran was verbally revealed by God to Muhammad through the angel Gabriel.
<b>Torah</b>	The first 5 books of Moses in the bible. These books form the basis of Jewish law and practice.
