Key Vocabulary

Harvest Festival	a celebration held in churches and schools in the autumn to give thanks for the crops and food.
Sukkot	a Jewish festival held in the autumn to commemorate the sheltering of the Israelites in the wilderness. It is marked by the erection of small booths covered in natural materials.
Thanksgiving	the expression of gratitude, especially to God. In Northern American this is an annual national holiday marked by religious observances and a traditional meal. The holiday commemorates a harvest festival celebrated by the Pilgrim Fathers in 1621, and is held in the US on the fourth Thursday in November. A similar holiday is held in Canada, usually on the second Monday in October
