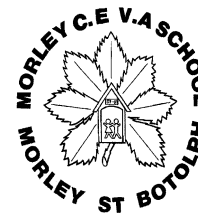

### **Vehicular access to school**

I am sure you are all aware of the new cone and chain barrier at the entrance to the school. It has been necessary to implement this to keep children safe when arriving and leaving the school. The barrier will be in place from 8.35am to 8.50am each morning so if you have been given permission to use the car park you must arrive before 8.35am. In the afternoon, the barrier will be in place between 3.10pm and 3.25pm. during which time no vehicles will be able to access (or leave) the carpark except for the taxi which will be seen out by a member of staff. Can I also remind parents not to stop on the zig zag lines at the front of the school as it hazardous to pedestrians and other road users. Thank you for your co-operation.
