

Morley Summer Reading Challenge 2020

Read in an unusual place
The more unusual the better.

Read to your teddy
Or
Read to a pet

Read to someone over the phone or net.

Read an information book. Share your knowledge with someone you know.

Read a poem
Listen to someone reading a poem on the internet

Listen to someone else reading a story to you. This could be someone older or someone younger.

Listen to someone reading a story on the internet or radio.

Re – read a book you know really well and see if you can discover something you didn't already know.

Tell a story to someone It could be a story you know well or one you have made up yourself.

Recite a poem you have learnt by heart.

Read outside.

Read a recipe or instructions.
Follow them to make something.

Read for 10 consecutive days.
You can do this more than once!

Read a picture book.
It may or may not have words.

Read something someone else in your class (or family) has written. Look on Google Classroom or the storybird website.

Read or listen to a book by your favourite author.

Write a list of your top 10 (or 5) books.

Read something funny.

Read a magazine or newspaper with an adult.

Make a wordsearch that links with a book you have read.
