The Aum is the symbol associated with Hinduism.</p>	<p>Hindus believe that Brahma created the world. In the Hindu creation story: Vishnu was asleep inside a cobras coils The aum sound woke Vishnu up A lotus flower grew from Vishnu Inside the flower was Brahman Vishnu commanded Brahma to create the world. Brahma split a lotus flower into 3 and made the heavens, sky and earth. Brahma then created plants and animals.</p>	
<p>Christians say thank you to God for the world and everything He created through prayer e.g. before meals and attending harvest festival.</p>	<p>Christian stewardship refers to the responsibility that Christians have to use the gifts God has given them to look after the world. This can include looking after the environment and protecting animals.</p>	<p>Hindus and Christians both believe that people should look after the world because God or Brahma created it and everything in it is important to them.</p>
