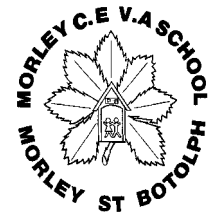

EYFS WEEKLY UPDATE – W/B 12th October 2020

Phonics teaching is going very well with the EYFS children. So far, they have learnt the sounds: s a t p i n m d g o c k ck e r and we are now going over these sounds each day together, saying the sound and thinking of things beginning with the sound. If you get the chance to practise these at home then that would be brilliant. Perhaps put them onto post it notes and go on a sound hunt around the house and then collect things beginning with that sound? We will be sending out more information on phonics and how we teach it in due course...watch this space!

Maths has had a focus on sorting and grouping; we used buttons to sort by colour, size, number of holes and talk about our reasoning.

We have learnt about the story of creation, have painted and drawn pictures and then decorated and ate biscuits that represented the first day of creation: day and night (We think this was the highlight of the week!)

The children worked together to come up with a class code, and the children are trying hard to follow this so that we all have a happy and kind time in Pine. Do ask your child about them.
