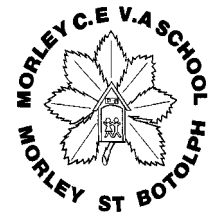

#### **Defibrillator**

We have been considering acquiring a defibrillator for the school for some time but our budget will not stretch to the cost of purchasing a unit. As the school site is too far away from the nearest defibrillator unit to be successfully deployed should the need ever arise, we have decided to focus all our Autumn Term fundraising efforts on raising money towards purchasing this important piece of equipment for the school.

Our School Council will be getting together soon to put forward their suggestions for raising some funds and all the proceeds from the Christmas card sales and Christmas Hamper ticket sales will also be put towards the fundraising effort. Our goal is to raise £1000.

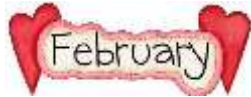
