#### Menu Change on January 6th 2022

#### Daily testing for contacts of COVID-19

From 14 December, a new national approach to daily testing for contacts of COVID-19 has been introduced. All adults who are fully vaccinated and children aged 5 to18 years and 6 months, identified as a contact of someone with COVID-19 – whether Omicron or not – should take an LFD test every day for 7 days instead of self-isolating. Children under five years old do not need to take part in daily testing for contacts of COVID-19 and do not need to isolate.

Once notified by Test and Trace as a close contact, all eligible staff, pupils and students are strongly recommended to take a LFD each day for 7 days and report the results through the <u>online reporting system</u> and to their setting. If they test negative, they can continue to attend their education setting. Outside of the education setting, they should continue to follow <u>national guidance</u>. This approach should also be adopted over the Christmas holiday and on return in January.

We also ask that you give your child an LFD test prior to their return to school on  $6^{th}$  January. In this way we can try to limit the spread of the virus within school.

Please can we ask parents to provide their child with tissues to use in school; there are many children in school at the moment with colds and runny noses. Thank you.
