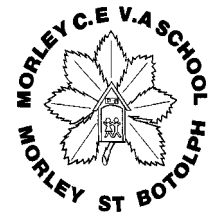

### **Author visit and Book sale**

James Campbell, the popular children's author, storyteller and comedian, is coming in to school on Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> March and will be running sessions with Oak, Sycamore, Rowan & Willow Classes.

James' books are available in all the usual bookshops and online places but he is also bringing a box of books with him to sell after school in the library. The books can be signed by him and dedicated to your child. Hopefully this will help cement the experience of meeting a real author and inspire our children to write for themselves. James has a card reading machine so he is able to take contactless payments, Applepay etc. He can also take cash.

James' new book is called **Write Your Own Funny Stories** and is published by Bloomsbury. It's a hilarious mixture of creative writing inspiration and exercise book. The idea is that as your child works their way through reading the book they also write their own funny book. This book costs £7

**The Funny Life of Sharks** is great for anyone who loves sharks, is terrified of sharks or anyone in between. Join James on his journey to discover more about these amazing animals. Great for anyone Y2 and above. This book costs £8.

**The Funny Life of Teachers** is a hilarious look at the world of teachers that everyone from Y2 to Y6 will love. It's particularly good for reluctant readers. Don't however, let teachers read it! This book costs £7

The first book in this series is **The Funny Life of Pets** and looks at humour to be found in cats, dogs, hamsters etc. This book costs £7.

James' four Boyface books are published by Hodder Children's Books. These are quirky and imaginative stories about a boy learning to find his place in a world of magical machines and unusual zebras. They were written in a certain order but you don't have to read them in that order. Most people start with the first one but it is quite possible to read them out of sequence. They will still make sense! The order they were written in however, is:

- 1 – Boyface and the Quantum Chromatic Disruption Machine**
- 2 – Boyface and the Tartan Badger**
- 3 – Boyface and the Uncertain Ponies**
- 4 – Boyface and the Power of Three And A Bit**

The Boyface books cost £6 each and are aimed at Y2, Y3, Y4, Y5 and Y6. However, Y1 and Reception can enjoy them with a bit of help.

### **Norfolk County Council's Big Norfolk Holiday Fun at Easter**

After the success of their 2021 Holiday Activity programme, we are pleased to report that the Norfolk County Council's Big Norfolk Holiday Fun Easter holiday activity scheme will be launching soon. The scheme will combine lots of fun activities to help keep children and young people busy and active during the holidays.

The scheme is due to run from the 4<sup>th</sup> - 19<sup>th</sup> April for children aged 5-16 (and 4 year olds in reception classes) and is free to those children who are eligible for means tested free school meals. **If you are interested in booking places and your child is eligible for free school meals, please contact the school office for the code you will need when applying.**

Any child can take part in Big Norfolk Festive Holiday Fun activities, but priority is given to children eligible for free school meals. Families of non-eligible children may have to pay for activities.
