VOCABULARY

Printing—paint is applied to a shaped object before being transferred to the paper.

Media—the materials used to create a piece of artwork

Textile—using fabrics and materials

Collage—a piece of art made by sticking various different media (such as pictures, textiles, photographs, paper) onto a backing

Texture—the feel of a surface of a material

Needle—tool used to join fabrics together by pulling a coloured thread through them both

Stitch— a particular way to control the needle to achieve a different pattern of thread on your material
