

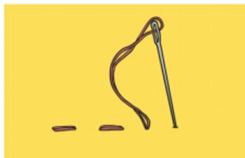
## LEARNING

## TECHNIQUES

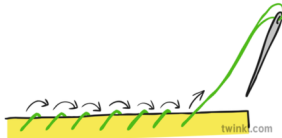

## VOCABULARY

**Printing**—paint is applied to a shaped object before being transferred to the paper.

**Media**—the materials used to create a piece of artwork

**Textile**—using fabrics and materials

**Collage**—a piece of art made by sticking various different media (such as pictures, textiles, photographs, paper) onto a backing

**Texture**—the feel of a surface of a material

**Needle**—tool used to join fabrics together by pulling a coloured thread through them both

**Stitch**—a particular way to control the needle to achieve a different pattern of thread on your material
