Solid	A substance that has a fixed
	shape and volume.
Liquid	A substance that flows freely
	and takes the shape of the
	container.
Gas	A substance that has no fixed
	shape and is free to fill any
	space.
Changing	Moving from one state to
state	another.
Melting	Temperature at which a given
point	solid will melt.
Boiling	Temperature when a liquid turns
point	to a gas.
Water	Way that water moves between
cycle	being water vapor to liquid
	water and then back to water
	vapor.

Has fixed shape and volume



Takes shape of container Forms horizontal surface Has fixed volume



Expands to fill container














Changing States of Water
