What makes themselves and others special-

Recognise some of the things that make them special Describe ways they are similar and different to others Understand that everyone has something about them that makes them special

Vocabulary

Similar - having characteristics in common **Different** - not the same as each other or one another Attribute - a quality or a feature regarded as a characteristic of someone Special -better, greater or otherwise different from what is usual Unique -being the only one of its kind, unlike anything else Helpful -giving or ready to give help Unhelpful -not helpful Co-operative -assistance in working towards a common goal Behaviour - the way in which a person behaves in response to a particular situation **Resolve** - settle or find a solution to a problem **Positive** - constructive, optimistic or confident Roles - the part played by a person in a particular situation **Responsibilities** -a thing that someone is required to do as part of a job or
