Dear Parents/Carers,

Smartwatches and Fitbits

We have noticed that several of our children have returned to school this term wearing Fitbits and smartwatches. Our school policy is that a watch may be worn, including one that includes fitness tracking. However, we STRICTLY do not permit watches that can be internet-enabled or have a built-in camera. Please ensure that your children do not bring these types of watches into school. If we find that a child has brought one into school they will be asked to leave the watch with our office and parents will be contacted to collect it from us.

Teacher Strikes

You may have heard that teachers have voted to strike in the coming weeks. The first strike day will be Wednesday 1st February with further planned strike days on the 15th and 16th of March. However, currently, the teachers at Morley are not choosing to strike.

School Day

Just a reminder of the school timetable and some processes to follow. School gates open at **8.30am**, your child should be in school for registration at **8.40am**. If your child arrives after this time they will be recorded as late and this will affect their attendance figures.

If your child is unable to come to school because they are ill we ask that you notify the school as soon as possible, preferably by 8.45am. Some illnesses, such as stomach upsets or infectious conditions require children to stay at home for more than one day in which case we would not expect you to call but would appreciate an update on day 3. If we do not hear from you, we are required to call you.

Parent Consultations

We are returning to face to face parent consultation meetings which I am sure will be welcomed by parents. These will take place in the school hall on Wednesday 22nd February from 1.30pm to 6.30pm with a couple of exceptions. Rowan Class appointments will be available from 1.10pm to 3.50pm on Wednesday 22nd February and from 1.10pm to 3.50pm on Friday 24th February. Sycamore Class appointments will be available from 1.10pm to 3.30pm on Tuesday 21st February and from 1.10pm to 3.30pm on Wednesday 22nd February. If you are unable to attend, you will need to speak to the class teacher to organise an appointment at another time.

There will be appointment sheets available in the school office foyer from **Wednesday 25th January** for you to book your consultation time.

Remember, you need to score 80% of questions right to pass the quiz so try to do this as soon as you have completed the book.

Winners will be announced on World Book Day (2nd March) We will also have our usual dress up day so get thinking about what book character you would like to be.

PARENTS - All children should have their login to accelerated reader. Children can quiz on books they have read independently or with an adult or ones they enjoyed you reading to them. 
