

To do this, you need to read as many books as you can in your ZPD and quiz on Accelerated Reader. If you are reading longer books, do not worry, as these will score higher points as they take longer to read.

Remember, you need to score 80% of questions right to pass the quiz so try to do this as soon as you have completed the book.

Winners will be announced on World Book Day. We will also have our usual dress up day so get thinking about what book character you would like to be.

PARENTS - All children should have their login to accelerated reader. Children can quiz on books they have read independently or with an adult or ones they enjoyed you reading to them.
