Many parents have talked to us about anxiety in children. It would be very helpful if you could complete the very short survey (link below) to help us with future plans. The Mental Health Support Teams in Schools (MHSTS) are an early intervention service that support children and young people, their families and schools and college communities with mild to moderate mental health difficulties. Each MHSTS is allocated to specific secondary schools/colleges and their feeder primary schools within Norfolk. The team work in education settings and in the wider education community, both in and out of term time, including school holidays. Families who have accessed this service in our schools so far, have had really positive outcomes and experiences. MHSTS are keen to find out if there are any specific areas of support required by parents and carers so that they can target specific needs within our school community.
