Kidical Mass Norwich Ride -Sunday 7th May - 2pm, Chapelfield Gardens, Norwich Kidical Mass is a family cycle ride to celebrate cycling and show that we want to cycle and we need safe spaces to do so. This is a gentle cycle, for EVERYONE (all ages and abilities) with the aim to enjoy cycling as a group, improve confidence in cycling.. And, most importantly, to have fun!

Norwich will be joining 23 other UK towns, and more than 350 other rides worldwide with our Kidical Mass ride on 7th May (the weekend of the Coronation). Last year 90,000 children, young people, families and friends joined in worldwide! The Norwich ride will start from Chapelfield Gardens at 2pm and will gently process around the town centre (route tbc), before ending back at Chapelfield Gardens again. Everyone welcome: children on their own cycles, balance bikes, stabilisers, BMX, cargos, trailers, trikes, tagalongs. (We ask that children are accompanied and that vou're self-sufficient and responsible for any children you bring along. However, we'll ride as a group and there will be adults to lead the ride and help navigate any traffic).


Vacancy
