I'd like to begin the newsletter by recognising the enormous effort put in this week by our year 6 pupils. As many of you will know, they have been doing their SATs in reading, spelling, punctuation and grammar and mathematics. Through every assessment they have been amazing. They have shown resilience, determination, commitment to their learning and a maturity that says so many good things about them, not just as learners but as people. SATs are just a moment in time and does not define them but they have risen to every challenge this week and as a staff team we are so proud of them. I'd also like to say an enormous 'thank you' to all of the staff who have been involved in the tests this week and particularly to the Year 6 teaching team, who have supported the pupils academically and emotionally.

The rest of the school have been working extremely hard over the course of the last few days too. I have seen some wonderful learning in all of the classes and I am sure this will carry on being the case as we move towards half term. One of the pieces of work I am undertaking is looking at our curriculum and I will be talking to some of the children next week about what and how they learn. I'm sure the feedback will be very interesting and insightful!

I am pleased to say that I will be remaining in my role as interim executive headteacher until at least the end of the autumn term 2023. During this time the Trust will be actively looking to recruit a permanent headteacher and I will of course give you an update on this when I am able to do so.
