Message from Mr Carlyle

This has been another extremely busy week, where the school has been buzzing with activity. There have been multiple trips out from different classes, transition events, rehearsals for the production, training for staff for our phonics teaching, as well as all of the usual learning that goes on. Our school community has embraced this with energy and enthusiasm and have once again risen to all of these challenges.

Following an interview process that concluded last week I am delighted to say that Mrs Ketley has been appointed at Deputy Headteacher for the Morley and Tacolneston Federation. I am sure you all know what an asset she is to both schools and she will remain as SENCo as well as undertaking this role. This appointment provides really important continuity to the schools, as we look to recruit a permanent headteacher in the autumn term.

I am very pleased to say that Morley was awarded the School Games Gold Mark this week. This is a nationally recognised scheme that acknowledges our commitment to sport and PE. There are a number of criteria that have to be met to qualify for the award, covering different areas of PE and active participation in sport. A huge thank you and well done to Mr Clements and all of our children for contributing to this.

As we come to the end of term, I just wanted to reemphasize that holidays taken in term time can't be authorised by schools. Whilst we appreciate that the cost of holidays increases dramatically during the summer, the guidance from the Department for Education is clear with regards to the course of action that schools are expected to take. I will be setting out in September what the Federation's approach is to managing attendance to ensure that it is as high as possible, including the process for issuing fines where those thresholds have been met.

Rowan Class SAW project

On Tuesday, Rowan class were visited by scientists, artists and writers from the SAW Project. They started by learning about different plant diseases, before heading outside to have a look for infected plants around the school grounds. After that, they studied the plants using a microscope, and did a leaf pressing using petri dishes and agar to see if any of the microorganisms would grow over the coming days.

After break, they used inspiration from the plant diseases to write poems about plants. Then in the afternoon, they created rubbings using spaghetti, experimented



with creating a clay mould for plaster of Paris, and created ink images of leaves. Everyone in Rowan class had an enjoyable day, and the class is now full of budding young scientists, writers and artists. We would like to thank Jenni and her team from SAW and the John Innes Centre for the fantastic experience.


