'Plan Bee' is a FREE 3 week course aimed at parents or carers of children or young people with additional needs including suspected or diagnosed Autism or ADHD.

- Developing a plan to support your child in situations they may find difficult which can then be shared with grandparents, schools and others.
- Strategies for creating an environment in which your child or young person can thrive.
- Sharing experiences, challenges and successes with other parents experiencing similar issues and learning from these.
