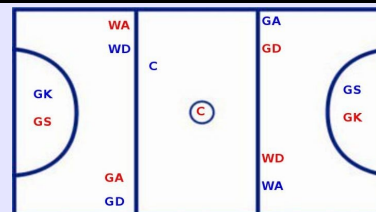

Key Vocabulary

Word	Definition
GA (Goal Attack)	The netball Goal Attack is only allowed in the centre and the enemy goal third including their goal circle.
GD (Goal Defence)	Netball Goal Defence Players are only allowed in the centre, their own goal defensive third, and their goal semi-circle.
GK (Goal Keeper)	Netball Goal Keepers are only allowed to play in their own goal defensive third, and goal semi-circle.
GS (Goal Shooter)	The netball Goal Shooter is only allowed in their own shooting circle and their circle third.
C (Center)	The centre can move around the whole netball court, except the two goal semi-circles.
WD (Wing Defence)	The Wing Defence is allowed in the bottom two thirds of the court. They cannot go in the goal circle.
WA (Wing Attack)	The Wing Attack is allowed in the top two thirds of the court. They cannot go in the goal circle.



Famous Sportsperson—Tracey Neville

Tracey Neville is a former England international netball player and coach of the England Netball Team.



She won the gold medal at the commonwealth games—a competition between countries which form a group called the commonwealth. This group is almost entirely made up of countries which used to be British colonies. She made the transition from player to coach after a serious knee injury made her stop playing. She was able to return to playing for one season but focused on her coaching, allowing her to stay in the sport. She has two famous footballing brothers—Gary and Phil Neville (Phil is her twin).
