Churches prepare to celebrate the arrival of Jesus during Advent. They wear purple and

decorate the church in purple as it symbolises royalty and reminds Christians that Advent is a time for

prayer, reflection and preparation.

Advent calendars, wreaths and candles are different

ways of counting down to Jesus' birthday.



Christmas trees symbolise the everlasting life of God

Mistletoe is a symbol of peace and joy and is used to show friendship and goodwill.

The orange - the world Red ribbon - blood of Christ

Cande - Jesus is the light of the world

The 4 cocktail sticks with fruit and sweets - the 4 seasons and all of God's creation.

Nativity The story of the birth of Jesus. Christians believe this story teaches them thankfulness and forgiving.
