Message from Mr Carlyle

I wanted to begin by saying a huge 'thank you' to the FOMPS for the winter fayre. It was wonderful to see lots of people in school last weekend and this wouldn't have been possible without the hard work and dedication of the team. I'd also like to thank the children who helped out on the day – they were amazing! Thank you also to those of you who were able to come – your generosity directly makes a difference to the children in school through the things that that will be able to access as a result of the fundraising.

We have had a slightly disrupted week this week, with the hall being out of action on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. I'm happy to say that it is back up and running and normal service has been resumed. We have very much missed the space at lunchtime but also those times when we come together as a school community for collective worship.

Our attendance levels for the term have generally been positive and we hope to continue this trajectory. It is perhaps worth reemphasising that 9 sessions of unauthorised absence in a 6 week period (the equivalent of 4 and a half days) will trigger a referral to the Norfolk Attendance Team, who can then pursue a fixed penalty notice.
