



<p><b>What are the key events from the story of Jonah?</b></p> <p>Answer to include the majority of the key events from the KO</p>	<p><b>When do you think Jonah might have prayed in the story?</b></p> <p>Accept any suitable answer e.g. in the fish to get out, to say sorry to God when he didn't do what God asked, to ask for help etc</p>	<p><b>How might Christians describe God?</b></p> <p><b>Give 3 examples</b></p> <p>Accept any reasonable answers:</p> <p>From the story of Jonah Christians believe God is loving, kind, fair and forgiving, and also Lord and King. Accept any three of these.</p>
<p><b>What are the 4 types of prayer?</b></p> <p>Ask, praise, sorry, thanks</p>	<p><b>How do Christians show their belief?</b></p> <p>Accept any reasonable answer e.g. praying to God, attending church, showing the story in art.</p>
